

On September 21, 2016, Petitioner, a California parolee, filed a pro se petition for a
writ of habeas corpus pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2254. On the same day, the Clerk of the
Court notified Petitioner that he had failed to pay the filing fee or file a complete <u>In Forma</u>
<u>Pauperis</u> Application and that he needed to do so within twenty-eight days or his case
would be dismissed. (Docket No. 2.) The deadline has since passed, and Petitioner has
failed to respond. Accordingly, this case is **DISMISSED** without prejudice for failure to
pay the filing fee.
