
**ORDER DENYING DEFENDANTS'  
MOTION TO DISMISS**

Presently before the Court is the motion to dismiss Plaintiff First Financial Security, Inc.'s ("First Financial") complaint brought by Defendants Michael W. Jones, Insurance Distribution Consulting, LLC ("IDC"), and Supreme Alliance, LLC ("Supreme Alliance") (collectively, "Defendants"). Mot., ECF 15; Mem. P. & A. ("Mem"), ECF 16. Defendants argue that the complaint fails to comply with Federal Rule of Civil Procedure Rule 8(a), because there are "zero factual allegations of wrongdoing." Mem. 6. The Court heard oral argument on Defendants' motion on July 20, 2017.

Having reviewed the complaint, the Court finds it adequately notifies Defendants of the claims against them. Accordingly, for that reason and the reasons stated on the record, the Court DENIES Defendants' motion to dismiss. Defendants shall answer the complaint **on or before August 21, 2017.**
