12 WARRANT FOR INSPECTION

13 TO: Diversion Investigator Marcie L. Johnson and any other duly  
14 authorized investigator or agent of the Drug Enforcement Administration ("DEA")  
15 of the United States Department of Justice.

17 Application having been made, and probable cause as defined by 21 U.S.C.  
18 § 880(d)(1) having been shown by the Affidavit For Administrative Inspection  
19 Warrant by Diversion Investigator Marcie Johnson of the DEA for an inspection of  
20 the controlled premises at 581 McCray Street, Hollister, CA., 95023 and of records  
21 for controlled substances maintained at the registered retail pharmacy location of  
22 ANSR PHARMACY 101, and based on the lack of any prior inspection pursuant  
23 to 21 CFR § 1316.09(a)(4)(i), the requested administrative inspection is  
24 appropriate pursuant to 21 U.S.C. § 880.


25 Therefore, pursuant to 21 U.S.C. § 880, you are hereby authorized to enter  
26 the above described premises during ordinary business hours to inspect in a  
27 reasonable manner and to a reasonable extent, all pertinent equipment, records,  
28 files, reports, official order forms, and documents required to be made, kept and

1 maintained under the provisions of the Controlled Substances Act ("CSA"), 21  
2 U.S.C. § 801 *et seq.*, for the purpose of verifying that said records, files, official  
3 order forms, reports, documents and controlled substances are properly kept and  
4 maintained.

5 You are hereby further authorized to remove from the above described  
6 premises all records, reports, documents, files, inventories and written information  
7 which are required to be made, kept and maintained under the provisions of the  
8 CSA, 21 U.S.C. § 801 *et seq.*, for the purpose of copying or verifying their  
9 correctness and accuracy. Any original documents so removed shall be copied  
10 and returned within fourteen (14) days of removal. ANSR PHARMACY 101  
11 shall be provided with a written inventory of any records removed for the purpose  
12 of copying.

13 A prompt return shall be made by the inspecting officers to the duty United  
14 States Magistrate Judge, showing that the inspection has been completed and  
15 accounting for all property removed pursuant to this warrant, not later than ten (10)  
16 days from the issuance of this warrant.
