ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On January 26, 2018, Plaintiff, a state prisoner, filed a <u>pro se</u> civil rights complaint pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. On the same day, the Clerk sent Plaintiff a notice that he had not signed his complaint as required by the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure. ¹ (Docket No. 3.) Plaintiff was advised that he needed to file a signed complaint on the proper form within twenty-eight days or the case would be dismissed. (<u>Id.</u>) The deadline has passed and Plaintiff has not filed the required document and has had no further communication with the Court. Accordingly, Plaintiff's case is **DISMISSED** without prejudice. The Clerk shall terminate all pending motions and close the file.
