Link v. Wabash R.R. Co., 370 U.S. 626, 629-33 20 (1962). Mr. Johnson is directed to file a written response to this order by January 15, 2019 and to appear before the Court on January 22, 2019 at 10:00 a.m. in Courtroom 2, Fifth Floor, 280 South 21 22 First Street, San Jose, California 95113 and show cause why this action should not be dismissed 23 without prejudice for failure to prosecute.
