**ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE RE
SETTLEMENT**

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14 The Court having been informed that the parties have settled this dispute, all previously
15 scheduled deadlines and appearances are vacated.

16 On or before **April 12, 2021**, the parties shall file a stipulated dismissal pursuant to Fed. R.
17 Civ. P. 41(a)(1)(ii). Rule 41(a)(1) permits a plaintiff to voluntarily dismiss a case without a court
18 order (i) by notice if the defendants have not filed an answer or motion for summary judgment, or
19 (ii) by stipulation signed by all parties who have appeared. Because the defendant has filed an
20 answer to the complaint, plaintiff must file a stipulated dismissal pursuant to Rule 41(a)(1)(ii).

21 If a dismissal is not filed by the specified date, then the parties shall appear in Courtroom
22 2, 5th Floor, 280 South First Street, San Jose, California 95113 on **April 20, 2021 at 10:00 a.m.**
23 and show cause, if any, why the case should not be dismissed pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(a).
24 Additionally, the parties shall file a statement in response to this Order to Show Cause no later
25 than **April 13, 2021** advising as to (1) the status of the activities of the parties in finalizing
26 settlement; and (2) how much additional time, if any, is requested to finalize the settlement and
27 file the dismissal. If a dismissal is filed as ordered, the Order to Show Cause hearing will be

1 automatically vacated and the parties need not file a statement in response to this Order.
