For the reasons which follow, 19 Plaintiff's IFP Motion is **DENIED**. 20 21 All parties instituting any civil action, suit or proceeding in a United States District Court must pay a filing fee. See 28 U.S.C. § 1914(a). An action may proceed despite a 22 plaintiff's failure to prepay the entire fee only if the plaintiff is granted leave to proceed in 23 24 forma pauperis pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915(a). See Rodriguez v. Cook, 169 F.3d 1176, 25 1177 (9th Cir. 1999). Plaintiff's declaration is missing page 2 and is therefore incomplete. Plaintiff's IFP Motion is therefore **DENIED**, and the complaint is **DISMISSED** 26 without prejudice. Pursuant to this order, Plaintiff is granted 60 days' leave to pay the 27 filing fee required to maintain this action pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1914, or to submit the 28 - 1 -
