The parties are ordered to file their joint motion for dismissal of this case, signed by counsel of record and all parties, no later than **February 19, 2009**. A proposed order on the joint motion for dismissal must be e-mailed to the district judge's chambers<sup>1</sup> on the same day. If the signed joint motion for dismissal is timely filed, the parties and

1 attorneys are not required to make any further appearances before Judge  
2 Major.

3 If the fully executed joint motion for dismissal is not filed by  
4 **February 19, 2009**, then all counsel of record and unrepresented parties  
5 are required to appear **in person** for a Settlement Disposition  
6 Conference. The Settlement Disposition Conference will be held on  
7 **February 24, 2009** at **9:00 a.m.** in **Courtroom A.**

8 If counsel of record or any unrepresented party fails to appear at  
9 the Settlement Disposition Conference, or the parties fail to file the  
10 signed joint motion for dismissal in a timely manner, the Court will  
11 issue an Order to Show Cause why sanctions should not be imposed for  
12 failing to comply with this Order.

13 All other pending dates before Magistrate Judge Major are hereby  
14 vacated. Any matters currently scheduled before the district judge  
15 shall remain in effect pending notice from that court.

16 **IT IS SO ORDERED.**
