No. 8] 16 Defendants. 17 18 19 20 On May 29, 2008, Jeff Gough-Adshima ("Plaintiff"), a former state inmate and proceeding pro 21 se, filed a civil rights Complaint pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. The Court issued an Order on July 3, 22 2008 granting Plaintiff's Motion to Proceed in forma pauperis ("IFP") and sua sponte dismissed his 23 Complaint for failing to state a claim and for seeking money damages against immune Defendants. (See 24 July 3, 2008 Order at 6-7.) Plaintiff was given leave to file an Amended Complaint but never did so. 25 On March 25, 2009, Plaintiff filed a "Motion to Vacate, Set Aside and Reopen the Civil 26 Proceedings" pursuant to FED.R.CIV.P. 60(b) [Doc. On March 30, 2009, Plaintiff's Motion for Relief from Judgment [Doc. No. 5] pursuant to FED.R.CIV.P. 60(b) was **GRANTED**. *See* Mar. 30, 2009 Order at 2. The Clerk of Court was directed to reopen the case. Plaintiff was also granted forty five (45) days in which to file a First Amended Complaint and he was informed that he must cure the deficiencies of pleading noted in the Court's July 3, 2008 Order. *Id*.

Plaintiff has now filed a "Motion to Reopen with Order to File Nunc Pro Tunc First Amended Complaint" [Doc. No. 8]. He has also attached a declaration in which he describes his attempts to file a First Amended Complaint. *See* Decl. of Jeff Gough at ¶¶ C-F. The Court will **GRANT** Plaintiff's Motion to Reopen and permit Plaintiff to file the First Amended Complaint which is attached to his Motion. The Clerk of Court is directed to enter into the docket, as a separate entry, the "First Amended Civil Rights Complaint" beginning on page seven (7) of Plaintiff's Motion to Reopen [Doc. No. 8].
