JUDGMENT [doc. #41]

Plaintiff Ester Burnett, appearing *pro se*, moves for default judgment against defendants Dugan and Hawthorne contending that default has been entered against them. (Motion at 2.)¹

Plaintiff is incorrect. Default has not been entered against these defendants. Neither defendant Dugan nor Kinji Hawthorne has been served² with the first amended complaint. Defendants Nasaria Barreras, Dev Khatri, M. Fraze and Victor Almager timely filed a motion to

dismiss the first amended complaint [doc. #34]

Plaintiff's motion does not contain page numbers. The Court refers to the page number provided by the e-filing system.

The "Service of Process by the U.S. Marshal" form was returned unexecuted as to Kinji Hawthorne, *see* docket no. 15, and Dr. Dugan, *see* docket no. 16. Because Dr. Dugan and Kanji Hawthorne have not been served, default cannot be entered against them.

Based on the foregoing, plaintiff's motion for default judgment against defendants Dugan and Kinji Hawthorne is without a legal or factual basis.
