21	The Court first notes that correspondence with a judge in a pending case is forbidden:	
22	Except as otherwise provided b	by law, attorneys or parties to any action or writing letters to the judge, or otherwise
23	communicating with the judge	vriting letters to the judge, or otherwise unless opposing counsel is present. All matters to should be formally submitted as hereinafter
24	provided.	
25	CIV. L.R. 83.9. Plaintiff's correspondence with the Court violates this Rule and will not be	
26	countenanced. Any further violations of this Rule shall result in sanctions being imposed on	
27	plaintiff.	
28	More importantly, a FOIA request dir	ected to a judge is outside the scope of the statute.

1	The FOIA makes certain government <b>agency</b> information accessible to people. See 5 U.S.C. §	
2	552. Governmental <b>agencies</b> have a duty to provide full disclosure of all records that are not	
3	specifically and reasonably exempt. In other words, FOIA applies to all 15 departments	
4	(Education, Homeland Security, etc.) and 73 other federal agencies (Environmental Protection	
5	Agency, Federal Reserve System, etc.) in the executive branch of the United States government.	
6	FOIA expressly does not apply to the president, Congress or the courts. Section 551 of Title 5	
7	specifically sets forth:	
8	For the purpose of this subchapter –	
9 10	(1) "agency" means each authority of the Government of the United States, whether or not it is within or subject to review by another agency, <b>but does</b> not include –	
11		
12	(B) the courts of the United States;	
13	5 U.S.C. § 551(1)(b) (emphasis added).	
14	Accordingly, the Clerk of the Court is directed to file plaintiff's correspondence as a	
15	FOIA request. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that plaintiff's FOIA request directed to the	
16	undersigned is <b>DENIED WITH PREJUDICE</b> .	
17	IT IS SO ORDERED.
