


1 dated June 10, 2010. The envelope containing Petitioner's motion was postmarked June 14,
2 2010 in Bakersfield, California. The Court did not receive the mailing until July 6, 2010.

3 The Court construes Petitioner's motion for an extension of time as a motion under
4 Fed. R. Civ. P. 60(b) to set aside the judgment. Petitioner may file his objections to the R&R
5 in support of the Rule 60(b) motion on or before **September 20, 2010**. Respondent may file
6 a reply on or before **October 4, 2010**. The Court sets the motion for hearing on **October 8,**
7 **2010 at 11:00 a.m.** Unless otherwise directed by the Court, there shall be no oral argument,
8 and no personal appearances are necessary.

9 The Court also **GRANTS** Petitioner's request for copies of Respondent's lodgments.
10 The Court **ORDERS** Respondent to provide Petitioner with a copy of the lodgments on or
11 before **August 16, 2010**.
