Claimant has agreed that by entering into this joint motion, he has not "substantially prevailed" within the meaning of 28 U.S.C. § 2465. All parties shall bear their own costs and expenses, including attorney fees. Judgment shall be entered in favor of the United States on its complaint.
- 5. Claimant has warranted and represented as a material fact that he is the sole owner of the defendant currency and has further warranted that no other person or entity has any right, claim or interest in the defendant currency, and that he will defend and indemnify the United States against any and all claims made against it on account of the seizure and forfeiture of the defendant currency.
- 6. The Claimant, his agents, employees, or assigns, shall hold and save harmless the United States of America, its agents and employees, from any and all claims which might result from the seizure of the defendant currency.

The Clerk of Court is instructed to terminate this case and enter final judgement accordingly.
