18	forma pauperis which reflects a \$138.44 trust account balance at the facility in which she is	
19	presently confined. It appears Petitioner can afford the \$5.00 filing fee. Accordingly, the Court	
20	DENIES the request to proceed in forma pauperis, and DISMISSES the case without prejudice.	
21	To have the case reopened, Petitioner must, no later than <u>January 15, 2010</u> , provide the Court	
22	with: (1) a copy of this Order together with the \$5.00 filing fee; or (2) a copy of this Order	
23	together with adequate proof that Petitioner cannot pay the \$5.00 filing fee.
