18	Plaintiff has filed a Complaint for predatory lending and mortgage fraud, along with a motion	
19	to proceed in forma pauperis and a request for appointment of counsel. Although Plaintiff is currently	
20	unemployed, the Court finds that Plaintiff's declaration of inability to pay costs or give security is	
21	insufficient to permit him to proceed in forma pauperis. Specifically, Plaintiff states that he receives	
22	a pension payment of \$2,700 a month from GM Corporation and has \$200.00 in a savings account.	
23	(Doc. 2 at 2.) His monthly expenses total \$1,677.10, which leaves him with over \$1,000 per month	
24	in income. (Id. at 3.)	
25	In light of this information, Plaintiff's motion to proceed in forma pauperis is denied DENIED	
26	and the Complaint is DISMISSED without prejudice. Pursuant to this Order, however, Plaintiff is	
27	granted 30 days leave to pay the \$350 filing fee required to maintain this action pursuant to 28 U.S.C.	
28	§ 1914, or to submit additional documentation regarding his economic status. IF PLAINTIFF
