18	The Court may dismiss a duplicative petition as frivolous if it "merely repeats pending
19	or previously litigated claims." Cato v. United States, 70 F.3d 1103, 1105 n.2 (9th Cir. 1995)
20	(citations omitted). Here, Petitioner has filed two identical petitions with this Court. The
21	Petition in this case was filed on May 17, 2010. An identical petition was filed in case number
22	10cv1034 on May 12, 2010.
23	Based on the foregoing, the Court DISMISSES this case because the Petition in this case
24	is duplicative of that filed in case number 10cv1034. The Clerk shall close the file.
