Approximately two months later, the Navy removed the case pursuant to 16 28 U.S.C. § 1442(a)(1). (Doc. No. 1.) The Court then dismissed without prejudice Plaintiff's 17 complaint against the Navy. (Doc. No. 17.) Plaintiff was given an opportunity to amend its 18 complaint as to the Navy, but failed to do so within the allotted time. With the federal party 19 eliminated from the suit, this Court declines to retain jurisdiction over the non-federal parties. See 20 District of Columbia v. Merit Systems Protection Bd., 762 F.2d 129, 133 (D.C. Cir. 1985); IMFC 21 Prof. Services of Florida, Inc. v. Latin American Home Health, Inc., 676 F.2d 152, 160 (5th Cir. 22 1982).
