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1	II. Conclusion and Order	
2	For the reasons set forth above, the Court hereby:	
3	(1) DISMISSES this action sua sponte without prejudice for failing to pay the \$350	
4	filing fee or file a Motion to Proceed IFP pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 1914(a) and 1915(a); and	
5	(2) GRANTS Plaintiff forty five (45) days leave from the date this Order is filed to:	
6	(a) prepay the entire \$350 civil filing fee in full; <i>or</i> (b) complete and file a Motion to Proceed	
7	IFP which includes a certified copy of his trust account statement for the 6-month period	
8	preceding the filing of his Complaint. See 28 U.S.C. § 1915(a)(2); S.D. CAL. CIVLR 3.2(b).	
9	IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court shall provide Plaintiff with the	
10	Court's form "Motion and Declaration in Support of Motion to Proceed <i>In Forma Pauperis</i> ."	
11	If Plaintiff fails to either prepay the \$350 civil filing fee or complete and submit the enclosed	
12	Motion to Proceed IFP within that time, this action shall remain dismissed without prejudice and	
13	without further Order of the Court.	
14	IT IS SO ORDERED.
