2	objected to." Id. "A judge of the court may accept, reject, or modify, in whole or in part, the
3	findings or recommendations made by the magistrate judge." 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1). When,
4	as here, no objections are filed, the Court need not review de novo the Report and
5	Recommendation. Wang v. Masaitis, 416 F.3d 992, 1000 n.13 (9th Cir. 2005).
6	The Court has reviewed the R&R and finds it to be correct. Because neither party
7	objects to it, the Court ADOPTS it. This action is therefore DISMISSED WITHOUT LEAVE
8	TO AMEND.
