

1 <u>Trust</u>, 463 U.S. 1, 14 (1983) (explaining that a case may not be removed to federal court on
2 the basis of a federal defense).

The removing defendant always has the burden of establishing that removal is proper,
and the court resolves all ambiguity in favor of remand to state court. <u>Gaus v. Miles, Inc.</u>,
980 F.2d 564, 566 (9th Cir. 1992). Defendant has not satisfied his burden. Therefore, the
Court **REMANDS** this action to the Superior Court of California, County of San Diego,
Central Division.
