WHEREAS, Defendant was personally served with the complaint on February 2, 2011;

WHEREAS, if the motion to consolidate the actions is granted, Plaintiff anticipates filing an amended consolidated complaint within five days from the date of such order;

WHEREAS, in the interest of justice and in an effort to enhance judicial efficiency and preserve resources, the Parties desire to allow defendants additional time in which to respond to the complaint;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE PARTIES HEREBY STIPULATE that the time in which Defendant shall respond to the complaint in this action shall be continued until 20 days after the filing
