19	The matter before the Court is the Report and Recommendation (ECF No. 15) of the	
20	Honorable Magistrate Judge Ruben B. Brooks recommending that the Court deny Petitioner's	
21	Motion for Stay and Abeyance. (ECF No. 7).	
22	BACKGROUND	
23	On May 19, 2011, Petitioner filed his Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus pursuant to	
24	28 U.S.C. § 2254 asserting claims that his due process rights were violated by his sentence and	
25	that he received ineffective assistance of counsel by his trial counsel (ECF No. 1). On	
26	October 31, 2011, Petitioner filed a Motion for Stay and Abeyance seeking a stay while he	
27	filed and exhausted a claim of ineffective assistance of his appellate counsel in state court.	
28	(ECF No. 7).

1	On June 28, 2012, the Honorable Magistrate Judge issued a Report and		
2	Recommendation recommending that the Court deny Petitioner's Motion for Stay and		
3	Abeyance on the grounds that: 1) the Petition is not a mixed petition containing some		
4	exhausted and some unexhausted claims and 2) the statute of limitation has run on Petitioner's		
5	unexhausted claim. (ECF No. 15).		
6	The Magistrate Judge stated:		
7	This Report and Recommendation will be submitted to United States District Court Judge William Q. Hayes, pursuant to the provisions of		
8	28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1). Any party may file written objections with the court and serve a copy on all parties on or before July 20, 2012. The		
9	document should be captioned. "Objections to Report and		
10	Recommendation" Any reply to the objections shall be served and filed on or before August 3, 2012. The parties are advised that failure to file objections within the specified time may waive the right to appeal the district court's order. <i>Martinez v. Ylst</i> , 951 F.2d 1153, 1157 (9th Cir.

13	To date, neither party has filed objections to the Report and Recommendation.
