**ORDER:**

- (1) ADOPTING THE MAGISTRATE JUDGE’S REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION (Doc. No. 210); and**
- (2) GRANTING PETITIONER’S MOTION TO APPROVE MINORS’ COMPROMISE (Doc. No. 209)**

Pending before the Court is the review of the Report and Recommendation, (Doc. No. 210), issued by the United States Magistrate Judge Andrew G. Shopler, recommending that Petitioner Robert R. Powell’s (guardian *ad litem* for minor plaintiffs H.R. and R.R.) motion for approval of minors’ compromise (“Petition”) (Doc. No. 209) be granted. Defendant filed a non-opposition to the Magistrate Judge’s Report and Recommendation. *See* Doc. No. 211.

Upon careful consideration of Petitioner’s motion and good cause appearing, the Court (1) **ADOPTS** the Magistrate Judge’s Report and Recommendation; and (2)

1 **GRANTS** the motion approving minors' compromise. Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY  
2 ORDERED that:

- 3 1. \$35,000 of the judgment paid by Defendant County of San Diego will be used to  
4 fund an annuity for the benefit of Minor Plaintiff H.R. Said amount will be made  
5 payable to Structured Assignments, SCC to fund periodic payments as outlined  
6 in Exhibit 1a<sup>1</sup>.
- 7 2. \$25,000 of the judgment paid by Defendant County of San Diego will be used to  
8 fund an annuity for the benefit of Minor Plaintiff R.R. Said amount will be made  
9 payable to Structured Assignments, SCC to fund periodic payments as outlined  
10 in Exhibit 1b.
- 11 3. Defendant County of San Diego's obligation to make the periodic payments  
12 described herein shall be assigned to Structured Assignments, SCC through its  
13 segregated cell, Class F Cell, by way of a Non-Qualified Assignment and funded  
14 by an annuity contract issued by Security Benefit Life Insurance Company. To  
15 fund the periodic payments, the County shall issue checks in the amounts of the  
16 annuities (\$35,000 and \$25,000) payable to Structured Assignments, SCC, and  
17 shall execute the Non-Qualified Assignments and Releases.
- 18 4. Said monies are not to be withdrawn until disbursed in accordance with the  
19 payment schedule set forth on Exhibits 1a and 1b hereto.
- 20 5. Unless otherwise ordered by the Court, said monies are not to be used for Minors  
21 H.R. and R.R. for necessities of life while they are minors.

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

- 1 6. The balance of the settlement funds will be disbursed as follows:  
2 a. \$350,000.00 in attorneys' fees, made payable to "The Law Office of  
3 Donnie R. Cox."  
4 b. \$72,217.90 in costs advanced, made payable to "The Law Office of Donnie  
5 R. Cox."  
6 c. The balance of \$217,782.10 made payable to "The Law Office of Donnie  
7 R. Cox Client Trust Account and Trevor Reynolds and Heather Camacho."

8 **IT IS SO ORDERED.**
