HAYES, Judge: 19 On February 9, 2012, Plaintiff Dwight A. Nicholas, proceeding pro se, initiated this 20 21 action by filing a Complaint in this Court. (ECF No. 1). On that same day, Plaintiff filed a Motion to Proceed IFP (ECF No. 2). 22 23 On March 13, 2012, this Court issued an Order stating: After considering Plaintiff's motion and the accompanying affidavit, the Court determines that Plaintiff can afford to pay the filing 24 25 fee in this case. Plaintiff has income and real estate assets necessary to pay the required \$350.00. Plaintiff does not have dependents or debts. Plaintiff is not eligible to proceed in forma pauperis pursuant to 28 26 U.S.C. § 1915(a). 27 Plaintiff's motion to proceed in forma pauperis (ECF No. 2) is DENIED without prejudice. No later than thirty days from the date of 28 this Order, Plaintiff shall either: (1) pay the requisite \$350.00 filing

fee; or (2) submit a more detailed and comprehensive motion to proceed in forma pauperis. If Plaintiff fails to submit payment or an amended motion to proceed in forma pauperis the Court will close this case. (ECF No. 3 at 2) To date, Plaintiff has failed to submit payment or to submit an amended motion to proceed in forma pauperis. Accordingly, this case is closed. IT IS SO ORDERED.
