ORDER GRANTING IN PART MOTION FOR LEAVE TO FILE SUPPLEMENTAL BRIEF

Before this Court is Defendants' Motion for Leave of Court to Allow Defendants to File a Supplemental Brief to Their Motion for Summary Judgment. (Docket No. 26).
