Specifically, 17 Plaintiff alleges that he was transferred against his will and 18 without due process from the RJ Donovan Facility, where he was doing 19 well, to Atascadero State Hospital on the false grounds that he is 20 mentally ill. Doc. #1. 21 The RJ Donovan Correctional Facility is located in San 22 Diego County, which lies in the Southern District of California. 23 Thus, a substantial part of the events or omissions giving rise to 24

Plaintiff's claims occurred in the Southern District of California. See 28 U.S.C. § 84(b). Venue therefore properly lies in the

Southern District. See 28 U.S.C. § 1391(b).

Accordingly, in the interest of justice and pursuant to 28
