Diego County, which is in the Southern District of California. Therefore, Plaintiff's claim should have been filed in the United States District Court for the Southern District of California. In the interest of justice, a federal court may transfer a complaint filed in the wrong district to the correct district. See 28 U.S.C. § 1406(a); Ravelo Monegro v. Rosa, 211 F.3d 509, 512 (9th Cir. 2000). Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this matter is transferred to the United States District Court for the Southern District of California.

By this order, this Court does not rule on Plaintiff's application to proceed in forma pauperis and request for service, without prepayment of costs, by the United States Marshal.
