disclosure process. Any objections to initial disclosure will be resolved as required by rule 26.

- 2. The rule 26(f) conference shall be completed on or before **March 28, 2016**.
- 3. A joint discovery plan shall be lodged with Magistrate Judge Brooks on or before **April 7, 2016**.
- 4. The initial disclosures pursuant to rule 26(a)(1)(A-D) shall occur on or before April 11, 2016. Any motions addressing disputes related to initial disclosures shall be filed no later than thirty (30) days following the date the disclosures were due. The 30-day deadline will not be extended without a prior Court order; counsel cannot unilaterally extend the deadline. For example, ongoing meet-and-confer efforts or supplemental disclosures do not extend the deadline. A failure to comply may bar the party from filing a corresponding motion.
- 5. Counsel are ordered to participate in a telephonic attorney-only case management conference pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 16(b) with United States Magistrate Judge Ruben B. Brooks on <u>May 5, 2016</u>, at <u>8:30 a.m.</u> Counsel for Plaintiff is to initiate the call.

Plaintiff's(s') counsel shall serve a copy of this order on all parties that enter this case after the date of this order.

Failure of any counsel or party to comply with this order may result in sanctions. IT IS SO ORDERED.
