**SCHEDULING ORDER  
REGULATING DISCOVERY  
AND OTHER PRE-TRIAL  
PROCEEDINGS**

16 On **November 13, 2019** the Court held an Early Neutral Evaluation Conference  
17 (“ENE”) in the above-entitled action. ECF No. 44. Settlement of the case could not be  
18 reached during the ENE and the Court therefore conducted a Case Management  
19 Conference pursuant to Rule 16.1(d) of the Local Rules. *Id.* After consulting with the  
20 attorneys of record for the parties and being advised of the status of the case, and good  
21 cause appearing, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:**

22 1. The parties must file a joint motion for a protective order, which includes the  
23 terms of their agreement for handling confidential documents and information, on or before  
24 **November 21, 2019**.

25 2. Any motion to join other parties, to amend the pleadings, or to file additional  
26 pleadings shall be filed by **January 10, 2020**.

27 3. The parties shall designate their respective experts in writing by **April 17,**  
28 **2020**. The parties must identify any person who may be used at trial to present evidence

1 pursuant to Rules 702, 703 or 705 of the Fed. R. Evid. This requirement is not limited to  
2 retained experts. The date for exchange of rebuttal experts shall be by May 8, 2020. The  
3 written designations shall include the name, address and telephone number of the expert  
4 and a reasonable summary of the testimony the expert is expected to provide. The list shall  
5 also include the normal rates the expert charges for deposition and trial testimony. The  
6 designations must include the information the parties have agreed upon or that the Court  
7 orders. Accordingly, the parties must file their proposed terms on or before November 20,  
8 2019.

9 4. Plaintiffs shall file their motion for class certification on or before June 19,  
10 2020.

11 5. The parties are **ORDERED** to contact the chambers of Judge Major within  
12 five days of the District Judge's ruling on the motion for class certification in order to set  
13 the remaining case deadlines.

14 6. The dates and times set forth herein will not be modified except for good cause  
15 shown.

16 7. Briefs or memoranda in support of or in opposition to any pending motion  
17 shall not exceed twenty-five (25) pages in length without leave of a district court judge.  
18 No reply memorandum shall exceed ten (10) pages without leave of a district court judge.  
19 Briefs and memoranda exceeding ten (10) pages in length shall have a table of contents  
20 and a table of authorities cited.

21 8. Plaintiff's counsel shall serve a copy of this order on all parties that enter this  
22 case hereafter.
