20 On May 12, 2020, the Court issued an Order granting Defendants' *Daubert* motion
21 and granting in part and denying in part Defendants' motion for summary judgment. *See*
22 SEALED Doc. No. 202. The Court directed the Clerk of Court to file the Order under
23 seal.¹ "Unless a particular court record is one 'traditionally kept secret,' a 'strong
24 presumption in favor of access is the starting point." *Kamakana v. City and Cnty. of*
25 *Honolulu*, 447 F.3d 1172, 1178 (9th Cir. 2006) (quoting *Foltz v. State Farm Mut. Auto.*
26 *Ins. Co.*, 331 F.3d 1122, 1135 (9th Cir. 2003)). The Court finds that compelling reasons

1 do not justify maintaining the entirety of the Order under seal. *See Ctr. for Auto Safety v.*
2 *Chrysler Grp., LLC*, 809 F.3d 1092 (9th Cir. 2016). Accordingly, the Court will issue a
3 redacted version of the Order.

4 To assist the Court in determining the appropriate extent of the redactions, the
5 Court **ORDERS** the parties to submit a joint proposed redacted version of the Order
6 directly to the undersigned's Chambers e-file address, efile_anello@casd.uscourts.gov,
7 no later than **May 20, 2020**. The Court will review the proposed submission and issue a
8 redacted version of the May 12, 2020 Order shortly thereafter.
