

Rule VII. Further, counsel's declaration does not state whether Plaintiff's counsel opposes or joins the motion. Nevertheless, Defendants' counsel did inform Plaintiff's counsel of this motion on November 13, 2020, and through Defendants' earlier filed motion, which the Court rejected on discrepancy.
