**ORDER DISMISSING CIVIL
ACTION FOR FAILING TO PAY
FILING FEE OR MOVE TO
PROCEED IN FORMA PAUPERIS
AND FOR FAILING TO COMPLY
WITH COURT ORDER**

20 Plaintiff Paul Blackmer, an inmate currently incarcerated at New Hampshire State
21 Prison for Men, and proceeding *pro se*, filed this civil action on March 22, 2021. *See*
22 Doc. No. 1.

23 **I. Procedural History**

24 On April 5, 2021, the Court dismissed this action for failing to pay the filing fee
25 required by 28 U.S.C. § 1914(a) or alternatively, filing a motion to proceed *in forma*
26 *pauperis* (“IFP”). *See* Doc. No. 4. Plaintiff was granted forty-five (45) days leave to
27 prepay the entire \$402 civil filing and administrative fee or complete a motion to proceed
28 IFP. *Id.* at 2.

1 Plaintiff had until May 20, 2021 to comply with the Court's Order. But to date,
2 Plaintiff has not paid the fee or filed a motion to proceed IFP, and has not requested an
3 extension of time in which to do so.


4 **II. Conclusion and Order**

5 Accordingly, the Court **DISMISSES** this civil action in its entirety without
6 prejudice based on Plaintiff's failing to pay the filing fee required by 28 U.S.C. § 1914(a)
7 or alternatively, filing a motion to proceed in compliance with the Court's April 5, 2021
8 Order.

9 The Court further **CERTIFIES** that an IFP appeal would not be taken in good faith
10 pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915(a)(3) and **DIRECTS** the Clerk to enter a final judgment of
11 dismissal and close the file.

12 **IT IS SO ORDERED.**
