**ORDER GRANTING JOINT MOTION  
TO FILE FIRST AMENDED  
COMPLAINT AND REMAND TO SAN  
DIEGO SUPERIOR COURT**


Plaintiff filed this action on November 26, 2024 in San Diego County Superior Court. ECF No. 1 at 6. On January 2, 2025, Defendant removed the action to federal court. *Id.* According to the Parties, Plaintiff received Defendant’s Initial Disclosures on January 28, 2025. ECF No. 14 at 3–4. Subsequently, on March 4, 2025, the Parties filed a joint motion to allow Plaintiff to file a first amended complaint and to remand this action back to San Diego County Superior Court. *Id.* Following a review of Defendant’s Initial Disclosures, Plaintiff requests leave to amend his complaint to add two new defendants with knowledge of facts related to this action. *Id.* at 4–5. If Plaintiff is granted leave to

1 amend his complaint and name the two new defendants, there will no longer be complete  
2 diversity between the parties, resulting in the Court losing its subject matter jurisdiction  
3 over the instant action.

4       Upon consideration of the parties' joint motion [ECF No. 14] and good cause  
5 appearing, the motion is hereby **GRANTED**. It is hereby **ORDERED** that Plaintiff may  
6 file a first amended complaint within **seven (7) days** of the date of this order. It is further  
7 **ORDERED** that upon the filing of the first amended complaint, this case shall be  
8 **REMANDED** to the San Diego County Superior Court.

9       **IT IS SO ORDERED.**
