**ORDER DIRECTING CLERK TO COMMENCE CIVIL ACTION AND
DIRECTING PLAINTIFF TO CURE DEFICIENCY**

Plaintiff has submitted a Prisoner's Motion and Affidavit for Leave to Proceed Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §1915, and a Prisoner Complaint. The court has determined that the documents are deficient as described in this order. Notwithstanding the deficiencies, the clerk of the court will be directed to commence a civil action. Plaintiff will be directed to cure the following if she wishes to pursue her claims. Any papers which the Plaintiff files in response to this order must include the civil action number on this order.

- (16) Sufficient copies to serve each defendant/respondent have not been received by the court.

FURTHER ORDERED that the Plaintiff cure the deficiencies designated above
within thirty (30) days from the date of this order. Any papers which the Plaintiff
files in response to this order must include the civil action number on this order. It is

FURTHER ORDERED that, if the Plaintiff fails to cure the designated
deficiencies **within thirty (30) days from the date of this order**, the complaint and the
action will be dismissed without further notice. The dismissal shall be without prejudice.
