5. **Plaintiff’s Motion to the Court-Chief Judge in Regards to Delay on Summary Judgement** [Doc. #144, filed 03/03/2009];

6. Plaintiff's Second Motion to the Court in Redargs to Delay on Summary Gudgegment on his Case and a Call for the Chief Judge to Make a Decision [Doc. #146, filed 04/06/2009]; and
