This matter is before me *sua sponte*. On April 28, 2009, the jury entered a verdict in favor of plaintiffs in this matter and apportioned fault to defendant of twenty-five percent (25%). On October 20, 2009, I denied defendant's motion for judgment as a matter of law [#310].<sup>1</sup> I enter this order to establish procedures for the parties to submit their proposed forms of judgment in this matter.

**THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED** as follows:


1. That plaintiffs **SHALL FILE** their proposed form of judgment and a concomitant brief in support thereof by **Friday, December 4, 2009**; and
2. That the time for filing of defendant's response and any counter proposed form of judgment and a concomitant brief in support thereof, as well as for plaintiffs' reply, **SHALL BE** as prescribed by D.C.COLO.LCivR 7.1C.
