**ORDER DIRECTING CLERK TO COMMENCE CIVIL ACTION AND
DIRECTING DEFENDANT TO CURE DEFICIENCY**

Defendant has submitted a "Motion for Subpoena of Documentary Evidence" in which he apparently asserts a claim pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act. Defendant has failed to file a Prisoner Complaint and he has failed either to pay the \$350.00 filing fee or to file a Prisoner's Motion and Affidavit for Leave to Proceed Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915. As part of the court's review pursuant to D.C.COLO.LCivR 8.2, the court has determined that the motion is deficient as described in this order. Notwithstanding the deficiencies, the clerk of the court will be directed to commence a civil action. Defendant will be directed to cure the following if he wishes to pursue his claims. Any papers that Defendant file in response to this order must include the civil action number on this order.

28 U.S.C. § 1915 Motion and Affidavit:

(1) xx is not submitted

- (2) ___ is missing affidavit
- (3) ___ is missing certified copy of prisoner's trust fund statement for the 6-month period immediately preceding this filing
- (4) ___ is missing required financial information
- (5) ___ is missing an original signature by the prisoner
- (6) ___ is not on proper form (must use the court's current form)
- (7) ___ names in caption do not match names in caption of complaint, petition or habeas application
- (8) ___ An original and a copy have not been received by the court. Only an original has been received.

Accordingly, it is

FURTHER ORDERED that Defendant cure the deficiencies designated above **within thirty (30) days from the date of this order.** Any papers that Defendant files in response to this order must include the civil action number on this order. It is

FURTHER ORDERED that the clerk of the court mail to Defendant, together with a copy of this order, two copies of the following forms: Prisoner's Motion and Affidavit for Leave to Proceed Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915; Prisoner Complaint. It is

FURTHER ORDERED that, if Defendant fails to cure the designated deficiencies **within thirty (30) days from the date of this order,** the action will be dismissed

without further notice. The dismissal shall be without prejudice.
