As further set forth on the record at the hearing held on February 18, 2010, IT IS  
HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

1. Plaintiff shall file either a motion to dismiss or a status report regarding her claim under Colorado's Anti-Discrimination Act on or before February 22, 2010;
2. Defendant shall file a status report regarding its position on an advisory jury verdict on Plaintiff's promissory estoppel claim on or before February 22, 2010;
3. Defendant shall file a motion in limine regarding Plaintiff's comparator witnesses on or before March 4, 2010; Plaintiff's response to the motion is due on or before March 18, 2010; and Defendant's reply to the motion is due on or before March 25, 2010;
4. A hearing on Defendant's motion in limine regarding Plaintiff's comparator witnesses is set for April 8, 2010 at 9:00 a.m.; and

5. Defendant's request to retain a vocational rehabilitation expert is DENIED as untimely.
