ORDER APPROVING STIPULATION FOR DISMISSAL OF THIRD-PARTY CLAIMS AGAINST CLASS CONSTRUCTION, INC.

Blackburn, J.

The matter is before the court on the **Stipulation For Dismissal of Third-Party Claims Against Class Construction, Inc.** [#698]¹ filed September 29, 2014. After reviewing the stipulation and the record, I conclude that the stipulation should be

approved and that the third-party claims of the third-party plaintiff Fidelity and Deposit Company of Maryland against third-party defendant Class Construction, Inc., should be dismissed with prejudice.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED as follows:

- 1. That the Stipulation For Dismissal of Third-Party Claims Against Class Construction, Inc. [#698] filed September 29, 2014, is APPROVED;
- That the third-party claims of the third-party plaintiff Fidelity and Deposit
 Company of Maryland against third-party defendant Class Construction, Inc., are
 DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE with each of the affected parties to pay its own
 attorney fees and costs;
- 3. That this stipulation does not involve any admission of liability or fault by Fidelity and Deposit Company of Maryland or Class Construction, Inc.; and
- 4. That third-party defendant Class Construction, Inc., is **DROPPED** as a named party to this action, and the case caption is amended accordingly.
