**ORDER OF DISMISSAL**

The matter before me is the **Joint Motion To Dismiss Pursuant To Fed.R.Civ.P. 41(a)(2) [#43]** filed September 11, 2009. After careful review of the motion and the file, I conclude that the motion should be granted and that Civil Action 09-cv-00125-REB-CBS, *American Heritage Title Agency, Inc., d/b/a First American Heritage Title Company of Denver v.
