The Stipulated Motion for Protective Order [[filed December 4, 2009; docket #86](#)] is **denied without prejudice**, and the proposed Stipulated Protective Order is refused. The parties are granted leave to file a revised proposed protective order (drafted separately from the motion and submitted to the Court in useable format, such as Word or Word Perfect) consistent with *Gillard v. Boulder Valley Sch. Dist.*, 196 F.R.D. 382 (D. Colo. 2000), in which the Court requires a mechanism by which the parties may challenge the designation of information as confidential. *See id.* at 388-89.
