## MINUTE ORDER

## ORDER ENTERED BY MAGISTRATE JUDGE KATHLEEN M. TAFOYA

This matter is before me on the "Stipulated Motion for Protective Order" (#21, filed August 28, 2009). *Gillard v. Boulder Valley School District*, 196 F.R.D. 382 (D. Colo. 2000), set out certain requirements for the issuance of a blanket protective order such as the one sought here. Among other things, any information designated by a party as confidential must first be reviewed by a lawyer who will certify that the designation as confidential is "based on a good faith belief that [the information] is confidential or otherwise entitled to protection" under Fed. R. Civ. P. 26(c)(7). *Gillard*, 196 F.R.D. at 386.

The proposed Protective Order does not comply with the requirements established in *Gillard*. The parties are granted leave to submit a motion for protective order and revised form of protective order consistent with the comments contained here. Therefore, it is ORDERED that the "Stipulated Motion for Protective Order" (#21) is DENIED without prejudice, and the proposed Protective Order is REFUSED.
