ORDER GRANTING JOINT MOTION TO STAY



1. Gypsum Ranch, LLC, et al.*, Colorado Supreme Court Case No. 09 CA 399 filed May 29, 2009, and if the Court accepts Certiorari, until a decision is rendered in that matter;

2. Until such time as the stay of this matter is lifted, the parties shall file a joint status report every three months, beginning August 13, 2009.
