**ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO

The matter before me is the **Stipulated Motion To Transfer Related Case And For Stay of Proceedings** [#17] filed August 14, 2009. With the approbation of the Honorable Christine M Arguello, United States District Judge for the District of Colorado, and the consent of the Honorable Wiley Y.
