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**ORDER DIRECTING CLERK TO COMMENCE CIVIL ACTION AND  
DIRECTING PLAINTIFF TO CURE DEFICIENCY**

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Plaintiff has submitted a Civil Cover Sheet, a Summons, a Motion and Affidavit for Leave to Proceed Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915 and a Complaint. As part of the court's review pursuant to D.C.COLO.LCivR 8.1, the court has determined that the submitted documents are deficient as described in this order. Notwithstanding the deficiencies, the clerk of the court will be directed to commence a civil action. Plaintiff will be directed to cure the following if he wishes to pursue his claims. Any papers which the Plaintiff files in response to this order must include the civil action number on this order.

**Motion and Affidavit for Leave to Proceed Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915:**

- (2)  is not on proper form (must use the court's current form)

- (8)  An original and a copy have not been received by the court. Only an original has been received.

**Complaint or Petition:**

- (10)  is not submitted
- (11)  is not on proper form (must use the court's current form)
- (12)  is missing an original signature by the Plaintiff
- (13)  is incomplete
- (14)  uses et al. instead of listing all parties in caption
- (15)  An original and a copy have not been received by the court. Only an original has been received.
- (16)  Sufficient copies to serve each defendant/respondent have not been received by the court.
- (17)  names in caption do not match names in text
- (18)  other: An application for a writ of habeas corpus challenging a conviction and sentence should not be submitted on a Complaint form. Applicant should submit his action on an Application for a Writ of Habeas Corpus Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2254.

Accordingly, it is

ORDERED that the clerk of the court commence a civil action in this matter. It is

FURTHER ORDERED that the Plaintiff cure the deficiencies designated above **within thirty (30) days from the date of this order.** Any papers which the Plaintiff files in response to this order must include the civil action number on this order. It is

FURTHER ORDERED that the clerk of the court mail to the Plaintiff, together with a copy of this order, copies of the following form: Application for a Writ of Habeas Corpus Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2254. It is

FURTHER ORDERED that, if the Plaintiff fails to cure the designated deficiencies **within thirty (30) days from the date of this order**, the action will be dismissed without further notice. The dismissal shall be without prejudice.
