IT IS FURTHER **ORDERED** that the Court accepts the Amended Complaint [Docket No. 63-1 at 2-11] for filing as of today's date.

IT IS FURTHER **ORDERED** that Defendant shall answer or otherwise respond to the Amended Complaint on or before **February 4, 2011**.

IT IS FURTHER **ORDERED** that a Scheduling Conference is set for **February 15, 2011 at 11:00 a.m.** in Courtroom C-204, Second Floor, Byron G. Rogers United States Courthouse, 1929 Stout Street, Denver, Colorado. Counsel shall appear in person. Plaintiff is excused.

IT IS FURTHER **ORDERED** that the discovery and dispositive motions deadlines are **vacated**.

IT IS FURTHER **ORDERED** that the parties shall submit their proposed scheduling order, pursuant to District of Colorado Electronic Case Filing ("ECF") Procedures. Deadline for submission of the proposed scheduling order is on or before **February 10, 2011**.

Parties shall submit a brief Confidential Settlement Statement to [Mix Chambers@cod.uscourts.gov](mailto:Mix_Chambers@cod.uscourts.gov) on or before **February 10, 2011**. Parties not participating in ECF shall submit their confidential settlement statement, on paper by

delivering to the office of the Clerk of the Court or by mailing directly to Magistrate Judge Mix at the Byron G. Rogers U.S. Courthouse. The envelopes shall be marked "Private per Magistrate Judge Mix' Orders."

Anyone seeking entry into the Byron G. Rogers United States Courthouse must show valid photo identification. See D.C.COLO.LCivR 83.2(B).
