ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Plaintiff initiated this action by submitting to the Court *pro se* a confusing document that he apparently intended to have filed as a pleading in a new civil rights action. Therefore, on September 15, 2009, Magistrate Judge Boyd N. Boland entered an order directing the clerk of the Court to commence a civil action and directing Plaintiff to cure certain deficiencies if he wished to pursue his claims. Specifically, Magistrate Judge Boland ordered Plaintiff to file a pleading on the proper form and either to pay the filing fee or to file a motion seeking leave to proceed *in forma pauperis* pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915. Plaintiff was warned that the action would be dismissed without further notice if he failed to cure the deficiencies within thirty days.

Plaintiff has failed to cure the deficiencies within the time allowed and he has failed to respond in any way to Magistrate Judge Boland's September 15 order. Therefore, the action will be dismissed without prejudice for failure to cure the deficiencies. Accordingly, it is

ORDERED that the action is dismissed without prejudice for failure to cure the deficiencies.
