ORDER DIRECTING CLERK TO COMMENCE CIVIL ACTION AND DIRECTING PLAINTIFF TO CURE DEFICIENCIES

pursue his claims in this action. Any papers that Plaintiff files in response to this order must include the civil action number on this order.
