## MINUTE ORDER

## Entered by Michael E. Hegarty, United States Magistrate Judge, on June 14, 2010.

For the same reasons set forth in this Court's May 3, 2010 and May 24, 2010 orders, the Unopposed Motion to Stay Discovery Pending Determination of Entitlement to Qualified Immunity filed by Defendants City of Fort Collins and Harrison [filed June 11, 2010; docket #76] is **granted**. The proceedings of this case are hereby temporarily **stayed** as to Defendants City of Fort Collins and Harrison pending the District Court's ruling on Defendants' Motion for Summary Judgment.
