MINUTE ORDER

Entered by Michael E. Hegarty, United States Magistrate Judge, on April 11, 2011.

Plaintiff's Motion to Stay [filed March 21, 2011; docket #126] is **denied**. Plaintiff asks the Court to stay the effect of the March 7, 2011 order on Defendants' motion to dismiss and to permit Plaintiff through May 2, 2011, to file a Second Amended Complaint and a motion for reconsideration.
